His Royal Highness Prince Mohamad Bolkiah then joined other ASEAN Foreign Ministers for a group photo session.



the purposes of this ongoing community projects.

Dayang Hajah Siti Hafsah also present new GGABD community project plan where activity unit had plan a community projects that can be carried out by members of any degree of age and position in the society.

"This is because each member is the beneficiary hopes to channel the spirit of PPPBD generations to come," she said.

Inauguration Of Newly-Fangled Rice Milling Facility

Bandar Seri Begawan, August 21-Yang Berhormat Pehin Orang Kaya Seri Utama Dato Seri Setia Hj Yahya Begawan Mudim Dato Paduka Hj Bakar, the Minister of Industry and Primary Resources officiated at the inauguration ceremony of the launching of the new rice milling processing complex at the Wasan Paddy Mill Centre in Jalan Limau Manis.

"This new complex has a grind capacity of 3.5 metric tonnes of padi per hour and if used all the time, will enable us to achieve 20 per cent rice production. In order for us to (attain) a 60 per cent (rice self-sufficiency rate), we will have to build a high capacity centre which can produce up to 7.5 metric tonnes per hour," revealed the Minister.

"The Ministry of Industry and Primary Resources (MIPR) is planning to build a high capacity rice milling facility that will allow the Sultanate to increase its self-sufficiency in rice production from the current five per cent to 60 per cent (equivalent to 18,000 metric tonnes) in 2015," the Minister added.

The project cost approximately BND\$5,010,272.00 and it purchase, supply and assembly of the machineries that can produce up to 3.5 metric tons of paddy per minute. In addition, such a feat will enable the

Sultanate to achieve its projected level of self-sufficiency up to twenty per cent with five thousand and eight hundred metric tons of rice per annum.

The MIPR is drafting a master plan to build a high-tech and high-capacity National Rice Processing Centre to attain rice production target in 2015.

'MIPR is looking to build the planned facility near the new rice milling complex in Kg Wasan." stated the Minister.

The new milling complex is estimated to produce local padi with an efficient rate while at the same time enabling the personnel to maintain tight quality control under the strictest possible scrutiny.

As a progressive measure towards achieving the self-sufficiency, MIPR is currently planning to increase the padi capacity to 7.5 metric tons per hour to fulfilled the maximum sixty per cent production rate, a plan that will soon be implemented by the Ministry in times to

Brunei Darussalam's current rice output only accounts for five per cent of local consumption. The Sultanate imports most of its rice requirements from Thailand and has recently started purchasing from Vietnam and Cambodia.
